Dear Parents and Caregivers,

Year 10 - RAA Street Smart High Excursion

On Tuesday 19 October (Term 4 Week 2) all Year 10 students will be attending the RAA Street Smart High at the Entertainment Centre.

Street Smart High is an annual road safety education event hosted by RAA in conjunction with event partner the Motor Accident Commission. Street Smart High aims to reduce the state's shocking youth road toll. Road crashes are one of the leading causes of death for young people under the age of 25, and Street Smart High aims to demonstrate the devastating reality of road trauma to South Australian high school students.

The Street Smart High program compliments the Road Awareness Program (RAP) and the South Australian Police Driver Education Program that all students complete in Year 11. As a school community we are committed to taking every opportunity we can to educate our students to be responsible and safe road users.

We have organised buses to take students from the College to the Entertainment Centre and back. Students should arrive at school at the normal time 8.40am and meet on the Netball Courts in readiness for a 9am departure, students will be dismissed at the normal time of 3.30pm. Students are to wear their normal Summer School Uniform and bring a packed Recess and Lunch with a bottle of Water, which they are asked to bring in a clear plastic bag.

RAA's Street Smart High will feature a realistic crash scene re-enactment involving vehicles, emergency and actors. The aim of this re-enactment is to be as close as possible to a real-life crash. It is not designed to shock, but to realistically portray the events of a fatal car crash. Students will also hear from people whose lives have been affected by road trauma. Counsellors will be available to help students who find the topics explored too confronting, or if they need assistance dealing with memories of loved ones who have been involved in a car crash. If you believe your child may find the experience too distressing, please contact their Head of House.
