



Rationale

- The conduct and management of tours should ensure that the school’s good name is honoured at all times.
- Overseas and Interstate Tours are a valuable and enriching part of the spiritual, educational, pastoral, cultural and sporting programs of Sacred Heart College. They enable students to further their intellectual, social and spiritual development in non-school settings and build upon classroom learning. They introduce students to a variety of experiences and activities which may not normally be encountered at school or in their own normal life experiences

Aims

- To reinforce, compliment and extend learning opportunities beyond the classroom.
- To develop an understanding that learning is not limited to school and that valuable and powerful learning takes place in other contexts and experiences.
- To provide a program of learning beyond the classroom that delivers opportunities for exercising resourcefulness, independence, leadership, judgement, cooperation, tolerance and spiritual reflection.
- To provide guidance on curriculum relevance and benefit and on procedural and logistical matters including frequency and cost.

Implementation
