



Rationale

The College flat Dareau, located at the rear of Paringa Hall, is named after Rue Dareau in Paris where the Marist Hospitality Centre is situated. Access to the flat is in recognition of the sacrifices many boarding families/carers make in sending their children to SHC and is, in a small way, an attempt to support families/carers when they are visiting their sons and daughters throughout term time.

Policy

Dareau is available for short term stays, free of charge, to all members of the Marist community, with a preference being given to boarding families/carers from SHC.

Conditions of use

- Boarders are not permitted to stay in Dareau without supervision.
- Boarding families, College staff, Marist Brothers, interstate\international Marist visitors and other members of the Marist network are able to apply to stay in Dareau.
- Preference will be given to the parents and carers of current boarders, subject to any existing legal arrangements or orders.
- The final decision as to who stays in Dareau is made by the Director of Boarding in consultation with the Principal, Deputy Principal and Operations Manager.
