Michael Green FMS is a Marist Brother and currently the Rector of Aquinas College in North Adelaide. Over the years, he has been a secondary teacher, school principal, tertiary educator, schools supervisor, and served as the founding National Director of Marist Schools Australia. His scholarship has focussed principally on Marist spirituality and history, and on Marist education, on which subjects he has written extensively, and presented in a number of countries. He has been a member of the International Commission for Marist Spiritual Patrimony since 2004, and was the author of the third volume of the *History of the Institute of the Marist Brothers* published in their bicentennial year in 2017.

In his presentation, Brother Michael will discuss the first two decades of the Marist Brothers' presence in Adelaide from the late 1890s, most of which played out in Largs Bay, Port Adelaide, and Semaphore. Both Sacred Heart College and Marist Brothers' Alberton (now part of Mount Carmel College) trace their origins to those years and places.
