All subject selections for current students for Year 11 2024 at Marcellin Campus will be submitted via Edval Choice.

<b>Step 1</b>	Access Website via <a href="https://my.edval.education/login">https://my.edval.education/login</a>
<b>Step 2</b>	Enter the individual <b>Web Code (emailed to student's school email address)</b> . Click on the "Forgot web code?" link if you have lost the email.  If you used Edval Choice last year, you <u>must</u> enter this <u>new code</u> . Otherwise, you will be taken to last year's Year 10 choices.
<b>Step 3</b>	Once you have logged in, click on <b>EDVAL CHOICE 2024</b> to take you to the Year 10 preference page. Please check the student name is correct (top right corner).
<b>Step 4</b>	Use the drop down menus to select subjects. You must select the equivalent of 12 semesters, plus 2 reserve preferences.
<b>Step 5</b>	Click on the <b>Submit</b> button.  Once selections are made, you will be taken to a new page confirming your choices. If you do not complete the form correctly, you will receive a message advising of the error. You will then need to reselect according to the information provided.  Make changes and click on <b>Submit</b> again.
<b>Step 6</b>	Print 2 copies of the confirmation page.  <b>One copy must be signed by a parent/caregiver and returned to your Homeroom teacher at by Tuesday 29 August 2023 (Week 6, Term 3).</b>  Please retain the other copy for your records.
