Step 1	Access Website via https://my.edval.education/login
Step 2	Enter the individual Web Code (emailed to student's school email address) . Click on the "Forgot web code?" link if you have lost the email. If you used Edval Choice last year, you <u>must</u> enter this <u>new code</u> . Otherwise, you will be taken to last year's Year 11 choices.
Step 3	Once you have logged in, click on EDVAL CHOICE 2024 to take you to the Year 12 preference page. Please check the student name is correct (top right corner).
Step 4	Choose one subject in each of the drop down menus (including 2 reserve choices).
Step 5	Click on the Submit button. Once selections are made, you will be taken to a new page confirming your choices. If you do not complete the form correctly, you will receive a message advising of the error. You will then need to reselect according to the information provided. Make changes and click on Submit again.
Step 6	Print 2 copies of the confirmation page. One copy must be signed by a parent/caregiver and returned to your Homeroom teacher by <u>Tuesday 29 August 2023 (Week 6, Term 3)</u>. Please retain the other copy for your records.

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Obtaining the SACE

To obtain the SACE, the following rules apply:

English, English Literary Studies, Essential English, English - Aboriginal Perspectives	Only 1 can be studied
General Mathematics, Mathematical Methods, Essential Mathematics	Only 1 can be studied

To obtain an ATAR:

Visual Art (Art), Visual Art (Design)	Only 1 can be used for an ATAR
Digital Communication Solutions, Material Solutions and Industry and Entrepreneurial Solutions	40 credits maximum
Integrated Learning subjects	20 credits maximum
Music subjects	40 credits maximum

Important! Please tick one of the following options:

- YES, I wish to qualify for an ATAR NO, I am not aiming for an ATAR

To be eligible for selection into a university course/program you must:

- qualify for the SACE
- obtain an ATAR
- meet any prerequisite subject requirements for the course/program.

To qualify for the SACE you must:

- complete 200 credits of subjects
- achieve a grade of C- or better in the Personal Learning Plan, 20 credits of literacy, 10 credits of numeracy and Activating Identities & Futures (AIF) at Stage 2
- achieve a grade of C- or better in an additional 60 credits at Stage 2.

To obtain a university aggregate and an ATAR you must:

- comply with the rules regarding Precluded Combinations
- comply with the rules regarding Counting Restrictions
- complete at least 90 credits of study of Stage 2 Tertiary Admissions Subjects (TAS) and Recognised Studies of which 60 credits must be 3 x 20 credit TAS from a maximum of three attempts which need not be in consecutive years.
