

Important information for Subject Selection for Year 12, 2024

You will be submitting your subject choices using Edval Choice. Your WebCode will be emailed to you when Edval Choice is available for selections to be entered.

- Be aware that many subjects have prerequisites. Refer the <u>Curriculum Handbook</u> to check that you have satisfied any prerequisites before choosing a subject.
- We recommend students choosing VET to select "Workplace Practices (VET)" as one of their 4 fullyear subjects. Students wanting to do VET in Year 12 must complete the VET Expression of Interest Google Form (emailed to students) to get their application underway.
- Students who have selected the **Cert III Entrepreneurship and New Business** or **Cert III Fitness** via the VET Expression of Interest Google Form, please select the relevant course as a subject in Edval Choice. If your VET application is not approved, this will be replaced with your first backup preference.
- Students doing the Stage 2 Workplace Practices subject for **elite dancers/athletes/umpires** through **Marden Senior College** should select a full complement of subjects. Your enrolment will not be confirmed until term 4. At that time, one of your full year subjects will be replaced with a study line.
- University subjects are by separate application. Please visit the Careers Office for an application form. Application forms should be returned to the Careers Office NOT to your homeroom teacher. You should still select a full complement of subjects in Edval Choice. A Stage 2 subject can be removed at a later time if your application is successful. We recommend commencing Year 12 with all subjects so you can make an informed decision about the best subject to remove when university commences in March.
- If you did a full year Stage 2 subject in Year 11, do NOT indicate this by choosing the subject Edval Choice else you will be enrolled again in 2023! You should still select a full complement of subjects. A Stage 2 subject can be removed at a later time (and certainly not before the SACE Board releases results). We recommend commencing Year 12 with all subjects so you can make an informed decision about the best subject to remove when the time comes.
- If you want to be **eligible for an ATAR**, don't forget there are some subject **counting restrictions** (see page 4 of your subject selection planning form or the SATAC Tertiary Entrance Booklet).
 - Choosing more than two of the following subjects means you may <u>not</u> be eligible for an ATAR: Industry & Entrepreneurial Solutions (3D Design & Manufacturing or Robotics & Automation), Material Solutions (Furniture Construction or Metalwork), or Digital Communication Solutions (Web Design).
 - o In addition, you may <u>not</u> be eligible for an ATAR if you choose a <u>Community Connections</u> subject (which includes Maths for Trade Skills, Woodwork, Kitchen Concepts and Small Business Secrets).
- Please print a copy of your Edval choices and ensure that you have a parent/caregiver signature on
 it in the place provided. Return the signed printout to your Homeroom teacher by Tuesday 29 August
 2023 (week 6).
