# Literacy Coaches

- Whole-school approach.
- Team teach in English classes from Year 7 to 9 with a focus on the explicit teaching of Literacy.
- Model effective differentiated literacy instruction in the classroom for the whole class; 2 lessons per week across all Year Levels.
- Actively identify students who may require intensive intervention and monitor progress.
- Develop a range of differentiated resources to support all teachers and students.

# Student Management at Champagnat Campus

# Student Management at Champagnat Campus

- Restorative Practice with non-negotiables (uniform/behaviour).
- Mobile phones are to be put away from arrival on campus to last bell of the day; confiscated if seen.
- First point of contact is Homeroom teacher, followed by Head of House or Assistant Head of House.
- Communication via email and phone, noting that we are usually in the classroom during school hours.

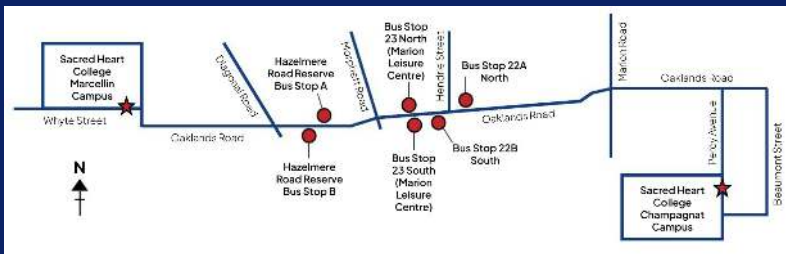
